



FUNDAYS 2018 Gilwell Park: Information for Coach Drivers

Fundays is an extremely busy event and there are limited parking and manoeuvrability facilities for large vehicles. Therefore it is extremely important that coach arrivals obey the following procedures. Please contact us should this be a problem.

At least one week before the event...

Please contact Gilwell Park on info.request@fundays.org.uk and advise us of your expected arrival time – this helps us plan our space requirements and ensures that your arrival is as smooth as possible.

Routes

Gilwell Park is situated approximately 5 minutes from Chingford and 10 minutes from the M25 J26. However, there is a specific route that MUST be followed as access to Gilwell Park will NOT be possible from Daws Hill. The revised route therefore is shown on the map.

Low Emission Zone

From January 3 2012, Transport for London have announced that some minibuses, large vans and other vehicles will now be impacted by the Low Emissions Zone (LEZ). As Gilwell Park is on the boundary of the zone, it is likely some visitors will enter the zone; therefore all drivers should review information at <http://www.tfl.gov.uk/modes/driving/low-emission-zone?cid=pp024>

On arrival...

On arrival you will be given specific instructions by the traffic management team, please note the speed limit is 5mph. The traffic management team will arrange for you to park in a suitable location where it is both safe for you to disembark your passengers, and for their equipment to be unloaded and conveyed to their camping location.

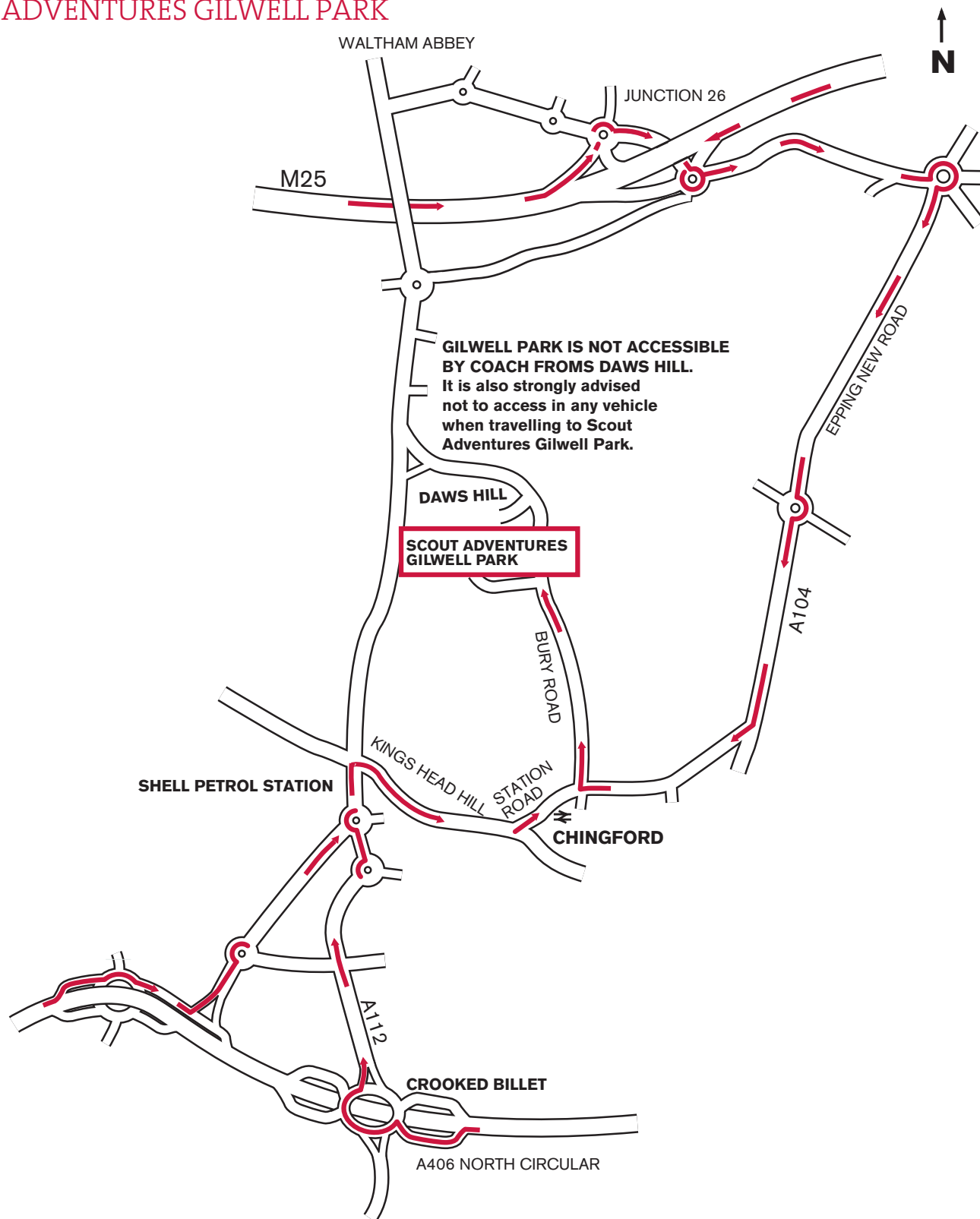
Wet weather

If for any reason we are unable to park on the fields, alternative parking arrangements will be made. We fully appreciate that this may cause inconvenience but it will avoid getting vehicles stuck and causing damage to both our fields and your vehicle. If it is necessary to follow an alternative parking plan, instructions will be issued on the day and your co-operation will be greatly appreciated.

DIRECTIONS TO SCOUT ADVENTURES GILWELL PARK



From Junction 26 of the M25 – Eastbound

1. At first roundabout, take 3rd exit for the A121
2. At second roundabout, take 2nd exit onto A121 (Westbound M25 from here)
2. At third roundabout take first exit onto A112 / Seward stone Road
3. Turn left onto Daws Hill
4. Road name changes to Bury Road
5. Turn right onto Gilwell Lane
