



FUNDAYS 2017 Gilwell Park: Information for Coach Drivers

Fundays is an extremely busy event and there are limited parking facilities for large vehicles. Therefore it is extremely important that coach arrivals follow the following specific procedures. Please contact us should this be a problem.

Five days before...

Please contact our Traffic Management Team on **07940474953** and advise us of your expected arrival time – this helps us plan our space requirements and ensures that your arrival is as smooth as possible.

Routes

Gilwell Park is situated approximately 5 minutes from Chingford and 10 minutes from the M25 J26. However, there is a specific route that **MUST** be followed for large vehicles as all other routes are unsuitable and could lead to damage to your coach or surrounding property. The route is shown on the Map below – please note other routes have width restrictions which are enforced. Gilwell Park is not accessible from Daws Hill

DO NOT FOLLOW SAT NAV.

15 minutes before arrival...

Before you arrive on site, it would help us if you could advise us when you are approximately 15 minutes away. For those arriving via the M25, please ask your group leader to call where possible at either J25 or J27. At this point they may be given specific arrival instructions which they should relay to you.

15 minute arrival notice should be given on 07940474953.

Low Emission Zone

From January 3 2012, Transport for London have announced that some minibuses, large vans and other vehicles will now be impacted by the Low Emissions Zone (LEZ). On arrival

On arrival you will be given specific instructions by the Traffic Management Team, please note the speed limit is 5mph. They will arrange for you to park in a suitable location where it is both safe for your passengers to disembark and for their equipment to be unloaded and moved to their location for the day. Your vehicle will be parked so that you are able to leave at any point.

Wet weather

If for any reason we are unable to park on the fields, alternative parking arrangements will be made. We fully appreciate that this may cause inconvenience but it will avoid getting vehicles stuck and causing damage to both our fields and your vehicle. If it is necessary to follow an alternative parking plan, instructions will be issued on the day and your co-operation will be greatly appreciated.

Refreshments

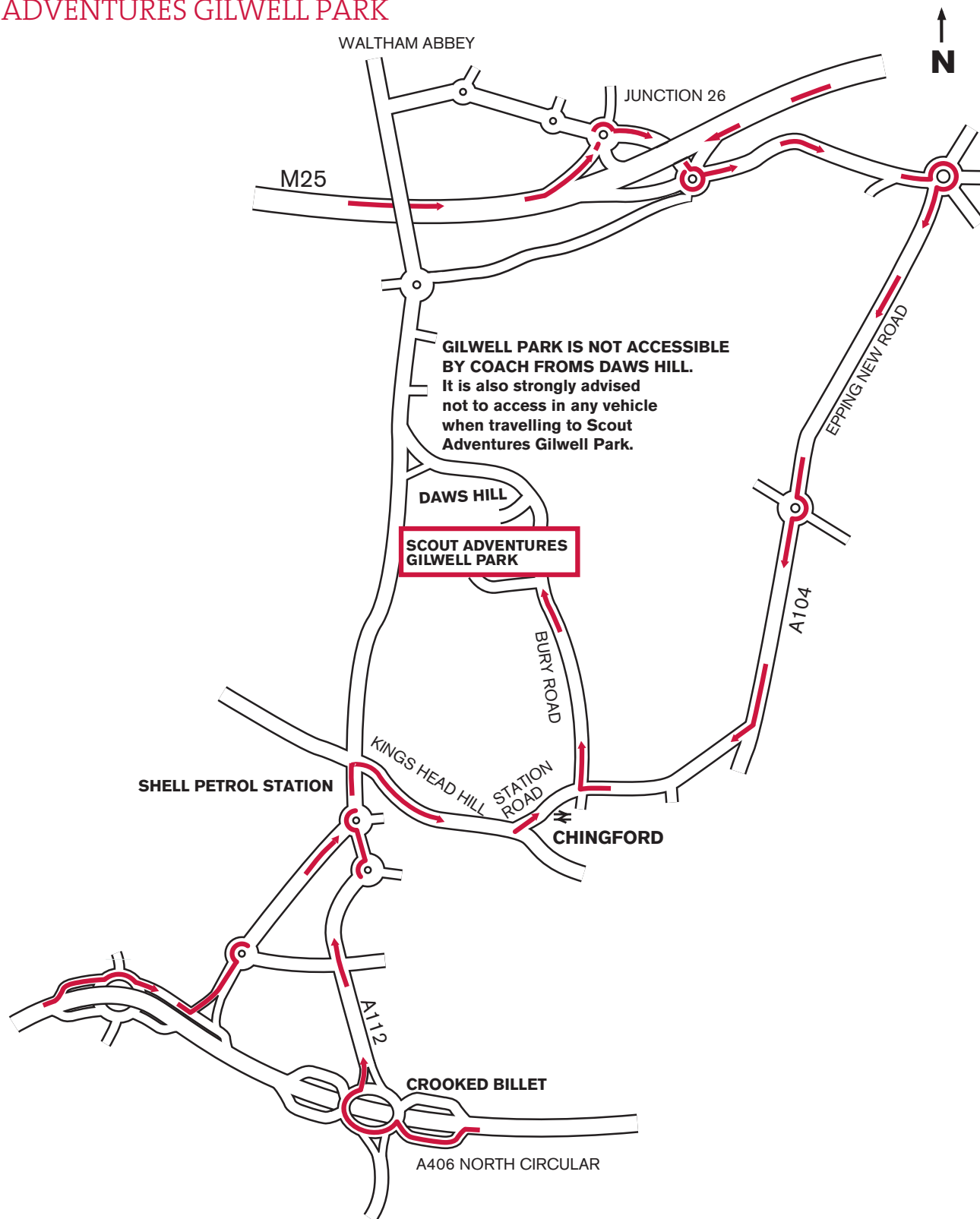
Please note that in 2017, breakfast will not be served from the White House. There are facilities on Camp Square for you to purchase breakfast.

DIRECTIONS TO SCOUT ADVENTURES GILWELL PARK



From Junction 26 of the M25 – Eastbound

1. At first roundabout, take 3rd exit for the A121
2. At second roundabout, take 2nd exit onto A121 (Westbound M25 from here)
2. At third roundabout take first exit onto A112 / Seward stone Road
3. Turn left onto Daws Hill
4. Road name changes to Bury Road
5. Turn right onto Gilwell Lane
